



Lisa Henderson Knits



This hat was created for my little cousin Aidan who is 3.

Almost no finishing and knits up quick in the round. Basic texture makes the variegated yarn stand out even more, and prevents pooling!

Materials:

US 7 (4.5 mm) Circular Needle 16" (40 cm)
Sport Weight Yarn: 24 sts per 4" in Pattern

Will stretch to fit

Baby Size 16 - 18" (110 yds) , Kids 18 - 20" (130 yds) Women's 20 - 22" (150 yds),
Men's 22 - 24" (170 yds)

Slip Stitch Pattern:

Slip2Fwd - this means to slip the next 2 stitches with yarn in the front of your work. This forms the little dash of yarn that you see on the swatch below.

Row One: *K2, Slip2Fwd,* repeat * to * across row.
Row Two: Knit across row
Row Three: *Slip2Fwd, K2* repeat * to * across row
Row Four: Knit across row

Hat Pattern:

With US 7 (4.5 mm) needles cast on 88 (100, 112, 124) stitches. Join in round.

Work 10 rows knitting each row. This will form the rolled brim.

Begin working in the Slip Stitch Pattern until 60 (68, 76, 84) rows have been completed.

With the stitches still on needle, flip the hat inside out.

Complete a 3 needle bind off.

You are finished! Weave in your ends.

You can also slip stitch the little "ears" on the hat from the inside if you wish.
